

Mass Intentions & Readings

Readings and Reflections

**First Reading** As a young man marries a virgin, your Builder shall marry you; and as a bridegroom rejoices in his bride so shall your God rejoice in you. (Is 62:5)

**Reflect:** The prophet Isaiah used marriage imagery (bride and groom) to describe the Lord's love for his people, Israel. What do you see as some implications of this marriage imagery?

**Psalms:** Proclaim his marvelous deeds to all the nations. (Ps 96)

**Second Reading:** But one and the same Spirit produces all of these, distributing them individually to each person as he wishes. (1 Cor 12:11)

**Reflect:** Paul taught the Corinthians that the individual gifts of the Holy Spirit are meant to benefit and unify the community of faith. How do you use your spiritual gifts within your faith community?

**Gospel:** Jesus did this as the beginning of his signs at Cana in Galilee and so revealed his glory, and his disciples began to believe in him. (Jn 2:11)

**Reflect:** Jesus turning water into wine at the wedding feast in Cana was one of the first public "signs" he performed revealing his divinity. It also showed Jesus' compassion, sparing the family shame at running short of wine. How do you imagine the family reacted to Jesus' intervention and rescue?




## Exodus 90

A journey into the desert of spirituality and asceticism for men. Many men are afraid of this challenge at the outset. But, by the end of the experience, they are more afraid that they resisted the summons to conversion. Here's the secret: Exodus 90 is not a one-time challenge, but an ascetical lifestyle rooted in the sacramental life of the church and it's growing all around the country. In 2011, Father Brian Doerr of the Diocese of Lafayette was appointed vice rector of Human Formation at Mount St. Mary's Theological Seminary in Emmitsburg, Md. During his time at the Mount, Father Doerr joined his men in the trenches of formation. He knew them because he spent time with them. He knew what they cared about what they struggled with and what they looked forward to in ministry. He soon realized that many of these good and generous seminarians were not as free as they could be as they approached ordination to the priesthood. What did their slavery look like? For some it was addictions. For others it was wasting away their lives on Netflix, videogames, new and other technological distractions. For still others, it was using food and alcohol as crutches to medicate the tough times. Perhaps this is scandalizing? But the lament of the Lord was their prayer "Let my son go, that he may love me." (Ex 4:23) Father Doerr took five of these struggling seminarians and issued them a 90-day challenge that would Change their lives forever. He did Not uncover a secret formula, but simply re-presented to them the tradition of the early church and her emphasis on asceticism. The number 90 was not coincidental or for some kind of secular marketing purpose such as a "Catholic P90X". Ninety was based off his reading of the sciences regarding the time it takes to return the brain to a normalized state and to begin forming new, lasting and healthy habits. There are two essentials for Exodus success: a) brotherhood and b) submission to the Exodus regimen. A man must have a fraternity to which he is accountable; this kind of growth is not possible in a co-ed setting in which true vulnerability is compromised. And the disciplines of Exodus 90 are not to be altered. This need to control is one of the major reasons men fail to be free in the first place. Control must be surrendered to the Lord.

**Question:**

**I can't explain it. I feel a nudge from God to something out of the ordinary. How do I respond?**

**Answer:**

You're in good company! Abraham was asked to leave all he knew and loved for a strange land, with only abstract divine assurance that such a sacrifice would be worth it. Plenty of prophets protested against God's call, whether it was claiming they were too young (Jeremiah) or running away entirely, only to end up in a whale's belly (Jonah). St. Joseph was asked to do something very strange. He was asked to believe — on the word of an angelic appearance in a dream — that his betrothed was pregnant not from another man, but by a miraculous intervention of God. Then he was called to marry her.

Author Flannery O'Connor once wrote, "You shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you odd." Sometimes God's invitation might seem strange or challenging. It might require sacrifices we never expected to make. Our life might look different than we had always imagined. But as we all know, life throws its own curveballs, regardless of whether or not we're listening for God's will. Better, one would think, to be open to the promptings of God and to follow along the strange trails that they lead. We have the assurance that, eventually, we will find green pastures.

Magnify 90 is a journey into the desert of spirituality and asceticism. "Holy Women are an incarnation of the feminine ideal; they are also a model for all Christians....An example of how the bride must respond with love to the love of the bridegroom" St. Pope John Paul II. *Auspice Maria*....Luke 1:46-47 "And Mary said, My soul magnifies the Lord and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior."

*Why women shouldn't do Exodus 90.* Men and women are complementary partners. We don't seek to be opposed to each other, nor the same as each other. We strive for the perfect union as Adam & Eve had before the fall, and this helps us both strive for the perfect union with God. We have one human nature, but two unique identities as man and woman. Exodus 90 gives men a way to root out attachments while fostering brotherhood that promotes them being spiritual leaders, that is, Christ to their (future/current) family/parish. Magnify 90 seeks to foster the complementary nature that God intended for men and women. If women want a more perfect freedom, we must complement our male counterparts—not seek to meld into one identity. Catholic women want equality and affirmation of our own dignity, not to take on the dignity of men. This is good! We are equal in dignity, so if we want to support men doing Exodus 90, the best thing we can do is find our own way to practice asceticism. His True Presence in the Eucharist is the source and summit of a life of grace. Yet, we aren't called to stay in the Adoration chapel every minute of every day. We are called to go out into the world and be witnesses of the Good News. Going to "the desert" is a choice. Do we choose to leave space to be still: Do we find God in the silence, in the brokenness, in the emptiness? This Magnify 90 journey asks us to foster a deep relationship with God and others. We can't let the current culture of the modern world continue to negatively influence our relationship with God. We must live in the world, we are called to be a light for the world, beacons of hope, a city on a hill! Let us link arms as desert sisters, and set the world ablaze with Christ's light by being the saints we were created to be!
